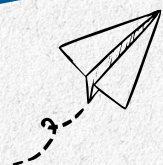

Secondary Target Group

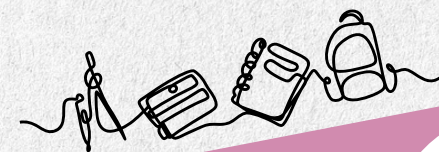
- Staff members of the participating organisations.

PROJECT'S OBJECTIVES

- To develop a greater understanding amongst primary school teachers of gender diversity and the impact of gender on peer-on-peer sexual harassment in primary school.
- To increase the chances that teachers are aware of such behaviours and have the tools to address, reduce and ultimately eliminate them.
- To increase the visibility of the project and multiply its impact, key messages and results.
- To increase the participating organisations' interdisciplinary cooperation.

PROJECT RESULTS

- Electronic guide with an introduction to peer-on-peer sexual harassment for primary school teachers.
- A series of animated short films that will help educators address the important issue of sexual harassment among students in an age-appropriate way.
- A Policy Brief that will highlight the advantages of incorporating the developed material into primary schools across the EU.
