



ARTEMIS: PREVENTING SEXUAL HARASSMENT & ABUSE AMONG PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The ARTEMIS project, developed under the Erasmus+ initiative, is a collaborative effort among partners aiming to combat sexual harassment among primary school students in Greece, Italy, Spain, France, and Portugal. Through thorough research, the partnership identified increased rates of harassment among classmates, causing feelings of isolation and insecurity among students. The project's primary goal is to empower educators with intervention tools while challenging prevailing stereotypes and fostering student awareness of behaviours that might be perceived as commonplace but have the potential to traumatize their peers. By raising awareness among students and influencing societal attitudes, ARTEMIS endeavours to create safer school environments and drive broader social change.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Enhance primary school teachers' **awareness** of gender diversity and its influence on peer-to-peer sexual harassment
- Equip teachers with the tools to **intervene** when they witness harassment behaviors
- Promote **interdisciplinary cooperation** among participating and other organizations
- Enhance project's **visibility** and amplify its impact by effectively communicating key messages and outcomes

WHERE ARE WE NOW?

The partnership had an online meeting on October 31, 2023, where they discussed about the path that they are going to follow to achieve all the goals they have set for the project. They converse about the creation of the first deliverable of the project which will be a Primary Educator's guide on peer-on-peer sexual harassment called "No Harassment" that will provide necessary information to both educate and empower teachers to better identify and address peer-on-peer sexual harassment.
